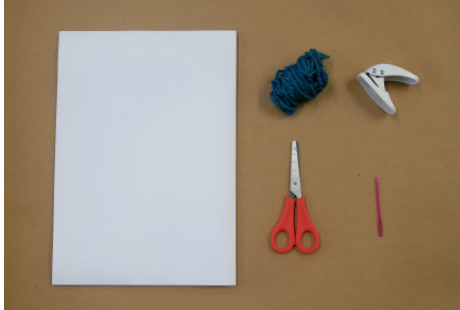


Stone: Ten Bindings by Faith Shannon

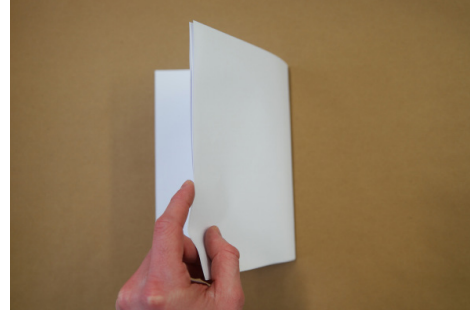
Pamphlet binding activity

1.



Take 3-4 pieces of paper, a needle, string, a hole punch and scissors.

2.



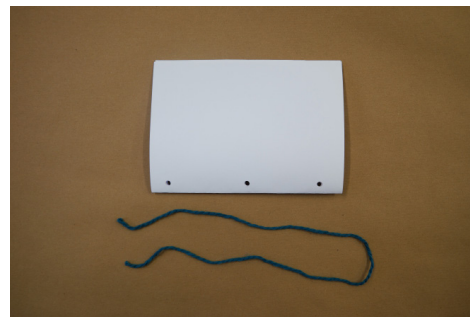
Fold the paper in half.

3.



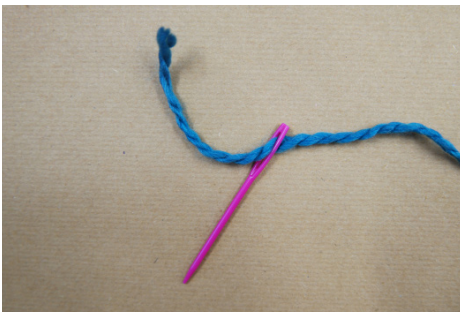
Use the hole punch to make three holes along the fold.

4.



Cut a piece of string, about twice the length of the paper

5.



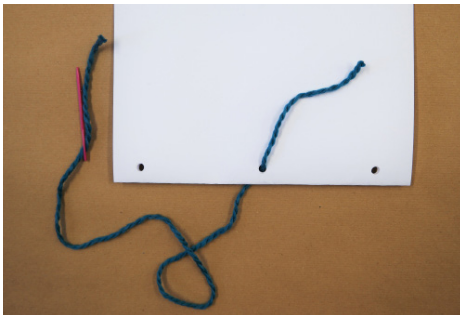
Thread the string through the needle.

6.



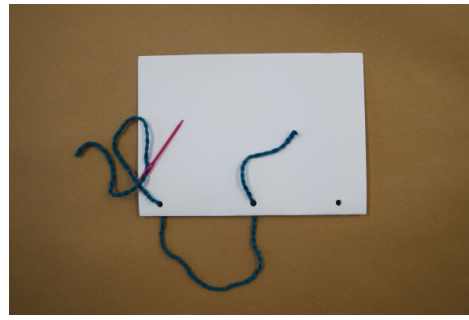
Pass the needle through the middle hole, from the front to the back of your paper.

7.



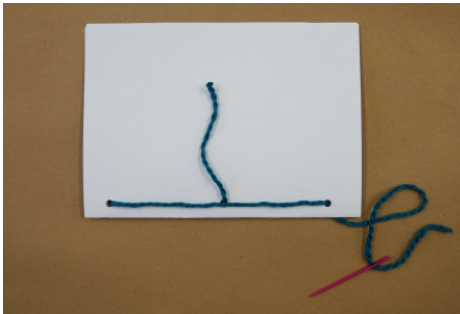
Make sure to leave some extra to tie a knot later.

8.



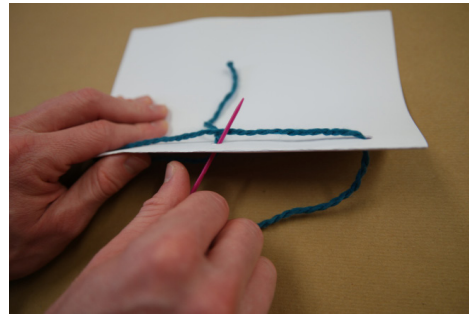
The needle will be at the back of the paper. Pass the needle from the back to the front, going through one of the end holes.

9.



The needle will be at the front of the paper. Going through the other end hole, pass the needle from front to back.

10.



The needle will be at the back of the paper. Pass the needle from back to front, going through the middle hole.

11.



Carefully tie the two strings in a knot to secure your book.

12.



Cut the excess string, then decorate your book!
